National Day of Prayer/Thursday, May 3 "If my people..." 2 Chr 7:14

The call to prayer has been a part of our national fabric from the beginning. In 1775 the Continental Congress asked the colonies to pray for wisdom in forming a nation. President Lincoln called for a day of "humiliation, fasting, and prayer" (1863). In 1952, by a joint resolution by Congress, signed by President Truman, an annual, national day of prayer was established. This law was amended and signed by President Reagan in 1988, permanently setting the day as the first Thursday of every May. Two local NDP functions will be at noon at Aledo City Hall and at 7:00 PM at the Doss Center in Weatherford.
